OLIVE CHEESE BALLS

2 c. shredded sharp Cheddar Cheese
1/2 c. butter or margarine, melted
1 1/4 c. flour
About 36 pimento-stuffed olives, drained well



Mix cheese and flour. Add butter and mix thoroughly using hands. Mold 1 teaspoon dough around each olive. Shape into a ball. Place 2-inches apart on an ungreased cookie sheet. Cover and chill at least 1 hour. Preheat oven to 400°. Bake 15 to 20 minutes.
