Jesus said to them, "All authority in heaven and on earth has been given to me. Go therefore and make disciples of all nations, baptizing them in the name of the

Father and of the Son and of the Holy Spirit, and teaching them to obey everything that I have commanded you. And remember, I am with you always, to the end of the age." (Matthew 28:18-20)

What an exciting and inspiring Holy Week we had this year. The Lenten season was a challenging journey for us as we talked about many of the uncertainties we face. Easter Sunday brought face-to-face with the proof that the Resurrection really did happen and set us on another journey yet to be mapped out. That is where I hope we can focus our thoughts and effort over the next several months. We will begin next Sunday with a message that asks the question: "After the Empty Tomb...What's next?" I want us to notice today that Matthew gives us Jesus' answer to that question in the verses above.

It is clear that Jesus has left the empty tomb behind and he wants us to do the same. He wants us to step away from the miracle and realize the mission that follows it. He doesn't want us to get stuck in the joy of Easter and fail to go forward into a broken world in need of us. In this passage, Jesus claims the authority of God and commands us to **GO-Make Disciples-Baptize-Teach.** This is not a suggestion, it is a direct order to "GO."

There many ways for us to satisfy this mandate; there are lots of places to "go" and do ministry. One of those is the local church and that's where we have the most opportunity to serve and honor God's command. This is certainly not the first time I have discussed this topic, nor will it be the last. But, I want us to really focus on this for the coming year. To set us on the path toward this focus on "going," I am urging you to attend an

All-Church meeting on Monday, April 9 at 7:00PM in our Family Life Center.

You may be aware that we have had a group called the Mission Strategy Team working over the past several months to gather information and research about our community. They have tried to identify who our neighbors are and what they may need. They have imagined the possibilities of how our Family Life Center might be used more effectively as a center for mission, outreach, and worship. It is a wonderful facility, but we use it largely for social functions for our own congregation and other groups. We do very little mission or "church" in this building. I do not believe that is good stewardship of the resources entrusted to us.

We have reached a point where we want the entire congregation to begin to dream and imagine the possibilities. We want to take the time to explain how the vision has changed since the building was first built. We want you to be involved and to become enthusiastic about going and making disciples, baptizing them, and teaching them about Jesus. That is the mission of the church. We must always love and care for one another within our congregation, but we must also always work toward helping new people find a relationship with Jesus.
