





# **Sunday School Returns**

Did you know that the word "methodist" was originally intended as an insult? When John and Charles Wesley started the "Holy Club" at Oxford University, they committed themselves to developing spiritual discipline in their lives. They did so in such a regimented way (using various "methods" to engage in spiritual discipline) their detractors called them

"methodists." Of course, John and Charles thought this was actually quite an appropriate name for what they were doing, so they took the name "methodist" for themselves.

One of the methods that was so important for the early Methodists was small groups. Long before there was a Methodist Church, the Methodist movement was centered around the formation of small groups. Wesley's classes and bands functioned as a place where people could be encouraged to engage in the means of grace and grow as disciples of Jesus Christ. Small group ministry has been a cornerstone of Methodist practice ever since.

While small groups have met throughout the pandemic, the structure of the Sunday School hour has not been available. With the recent change in CDC recommendations, I am pleased to announce that Sunday School will return to the church building at 10:00 am on May 30! Nursery and children's programs will also return on this day. The next couple of weeks should give our class leaders time to plan their lessons and get ready for the return.

COVID guidelines for Sunday School echo the CDC and our guidelines for corporate worship: those who are fully vaccinated may choose not to wear a mask, and we encourage those who are not fully vaccinated to continue to wear masks. If you are fully vaccinated but would prefer to continue wearing a mask, you may certainly do so! We ask that people are considerate of one another's personal boundaries.

I am very excited about this news, as this represents one more step in rebuilding the walls of our city (to borrow some imagery from Ezra and Nehemiah). There is still work to do and milestones to accomplish, but it is incredibly heartening to be able to take this step forward!




## KidZone News GREAT NEWS TO OUR KIDZONE KIDS!!!
